# PHARMACY RESIDENCY PROGRAM

#### **Overview**

Pharmacists at Baptist Health Medical Center-Little Rock provide patient-centered care through effective drug therapy management, working in collaboration with the entire health-care team to ensure positive patient outcomes. Our clinical pharmacists are extensively involved in the delivery of quality patient care through active participation in ICU team rounds, involvement in interdisciplinary patient care committees, and comprehensive decentralized clinical services.

#### Purpose

PGYI pharmacy residency programs build on Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D) education and outcomes to contribute to the development of clinical pharmacists responsible for medication related care of patients with a wide range of conditions, eligible for board certification, and eligible for postgraduate year two (PGY2) pharmacy residency training.

### **Application Process**

Applications will be accepted through online submission using PhorCAS, ASHP's centralized application site.

BHMC-LR participates in the National Match Service to choose its resident, so applicants must be registered for the Match.

- 1. Academic performance, exhibited from a copy of the most recent graduate college transcript
- Achievement of appropriate knowledge, skills, and attitude to successfully complete the outcomes of the BHMC- LR pharmacy residency program, as outlined in a letter of intent
- Three references from prior employers and educators
- 4. On-site interview

All application materials must be received by January 1. Candidates will be contacted for interviews in February.

This residency site agrees that no person at this site will solicit, accept, or use any Match ranking-related information from any residency applicant.

# Qualifications of Applicants

Appointment to the residency position is contingent upon the satisfaction of the following eligibility requirements:

- Graduate of ACPE-accredited Doctor of Pharmacy degree program
- Arkansas licensure before July 31 of graduation year
- Successful completion of required employment physical, drug/nicotine screen and background check
